TIBF is involved in numerous conservation projects, normally in conjunction with the Idaho Department of Fish and Game. Our activities generally involve habitat enhancement for all fish species. These projects often incur expenses for materials in addition to the donated time and money from our membership.

We stress youth involvement in an effort to expose young people to outdoor activities. These activities include educational "Reel Kids Casting Events" at various outdoor venues, the Scales of Justice annual tournament (where at-risk youth are introduced to a better way of life), the Catch A Special Thrill (C.A.S.T.) program for developmentally-challenged youth and numerous additional youth activities among member clubs. Additionally, TIBF sends 2 young people from Idaho to the National Guard Junior World Championship every year where they become eligible to win college scholarships.

The Idaho Bass Federation operates as a non-profit organization consisting of 11 bass clubs located throughout Idaho. Our membership is composed of approximately 400 Idaho citizens. In addition to our tournament activities, we are also deeply involved with various community activities.
