TIMES: Ooze off: 7:30 am or safe light **WEIGH-IN:** 1st Flight 4:00 pm, 2nd Flight 4:20 pm, 3rd Flight 4:40pm

LIMIT: Seven (7) fish, minimum size 12”

SPECIAL NOTES

-Checks, money orders or cashier check only required for entries

-Entries received by **Tuesday** March 23, 2010 will be included in draw for starting position.

-Entries received **after** March 23, 2010, will be assigned starting positions in order of receipt and the \$20.00 late fee will be assessed.

TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

Sportsmanship: Any contestant who displays poor sportsmanship, violates these rules, or is ticketed for violations of state fish and game laws and/or state law will be disqualified. Good sportsmanship and fair play should be directed at non-tournament anglers who may be on the lake during the period of the tournament as well as other tournament participants.

Safety: Safe boating conduct and all safety precautions must be observed at all times by all contestants. Everyone fishing the tournament must have a life vest and other safety equipment as specified by the Coast Guard. **Life vests must be worn and the kill switch attached to the driver when the internal combustion engine is running.**

Tackle: Only artificial lures may be used. No prepared or live bait, other than pork type strips or rinds, is permitted. Only rods and reels are permitted. Only one rod may be in use and in the water at any one time, however, any number of rigged rods may be in the boat for substitute purposes. Electrical and mechanical devices such as depth meter, color-lector, thermometers and oxygen meters may be used. Landing nets are permitted. A live well or suitable substitute is required.

Permitted Fishing Waters: This tournament will be a No Touch rule. All fishing must be done from a boat. All contestants must leave and return to the starting point within tournament hours. Water boundaries include all SLACK WATERS of Brownlee Reservoir from the RAILROAD TRESTLE Bridge upstream from Spring Camp to Brownlee Dam except for the buoys at the power inlet. There is no fishing in the launch ramp cove point to point.

Fishing Hours: Will be confirmed at the Pre-Tournament Meeting on March 26, 2010.

Checking in: All boats must check in at the official checkpoint, also to be announced at the Pre-Tournament Meeting.

Penalties: Contestants who have not checked in at the official check point on time will be penalized one (1) pound of weight for every one (1) minute of tardiness. Contestants checking in ten (10) minutes or more late will lose all credit for that day's catch. Boat and /or motor trouble are not exceptions. Anyone weighing in a fish smaller than twelve (12) inches will lose all credit for that day's catch. Fish will be measured mouth closed on a FLAT board. Fanning of the tail is permitted. All penalties will apply to big fish as well. Only seven (7) fish are permitted in boat live well. Boats with more than seven (7) fish will be disqualified for that day's contest. No contestant is permitted to be on the lake during off limits dates.

Scoring: Scoring will be determined by the total weight of each team's catch for the overall event. Tournament limit will be seven (7), twelve (12) inch or longer fish per team. A .25 lb. deduction penalty will be assessed for each dead fish weighed in. In case of a tie, largest single fish among contenders will determine the winner. In case of a tie for largest fish, the highest team weight determines the winner.

Complaints: Complaints must be submitted to the **TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR** in writing no later than 30 minutes after weigh-in. Decisions of the tournament officials are final.

Alcohol/Narcotics: Consumption and/or possession of alcoholic beverages and/or narcotics are prohibited while the boat is in the water. Narcotics with medical prescription excluded. Violation will result in disqualification.

Starting Position: No trading of starting positions. To do so will result in disqualification of all teams involved.

Motor Bands: Motor bands are required and will be available to anglers before the tournament for a \$20 deposit which will be refunded on return of the motor band at weigh-in.
