# The Idaho Bass Federation Junior Championship Rules

**Membership:** All contestants will be paid Premium Youth Members (\$25 dues) of a club affiliated with The Idaho Bass Federation.

**Ages:** There will be two age brackets for competition, 11 to 14 years of age and 15 to 18 years of age. The official age deadline is August 31<sup>st</sup>. A winner from each age division will be determined and that winner will proceed to the National Guard Junior World Championship at a date, time and location to be determined.

**Off Limits:** There will be no official off limits period for any Junior Championship.

**Chaperones:** Each contestant will be paired with another contestant and where possible they will be in different age groups. Both anglers compete from a boat driven by an adult. The boat driver cannot assist the anglers in any way including pointing out fishing areas, netting fish, tying lines, recommending baits or any other assistance that would amplify the anglers abilities giving them an edge over the rest of the field. Chaperones will do everything possible to insure the safety of the youth anglers and will prevent them from actions that could jeopardize themselves or others. No angler under the age of 16 will be allowed to operate the boat under power by the big motor.

**Boat Control:** Each angler may control the boat for ½ of each day. They may direct the boat driver (chaperone) to take them to a designated location and that travel time will count against their part of the day.

**Limits:** Each angler may bring to the scales 5 (five) bass with a minimum length of 12 (twelve) inches. Any fish determined to be short of the minimum length will result in disqualification of that days catch.

**Fish Care:** Each angler is responsible for the care of their own catch and may be assisted by the boat operator to insure the health of their catch. No dead fish may be culled and weighing a dead fish will result in a .50 (1/2) pound penalty. There will be no culling in the launch and take out area.

In the necessity of further rules, the TBF Official Rules will apply.
